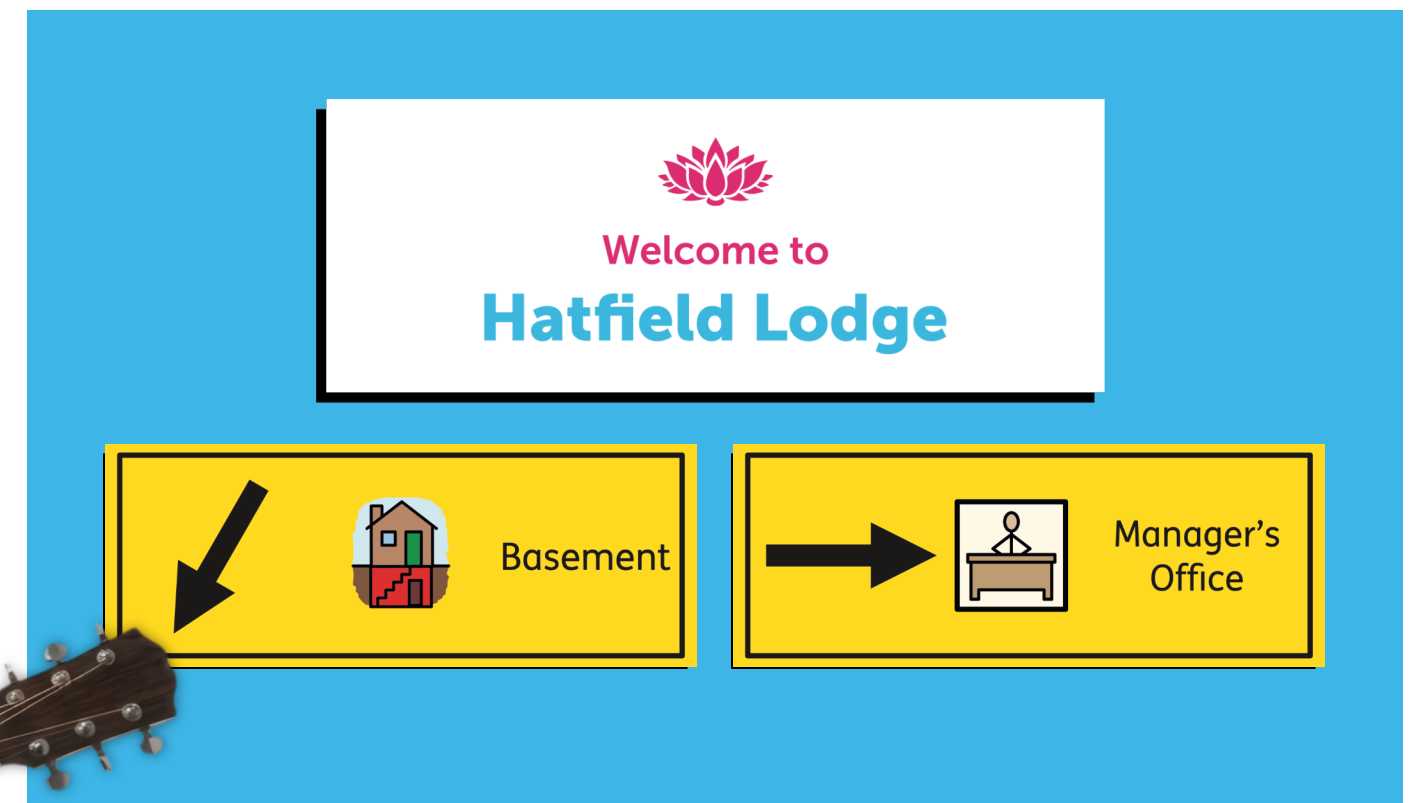
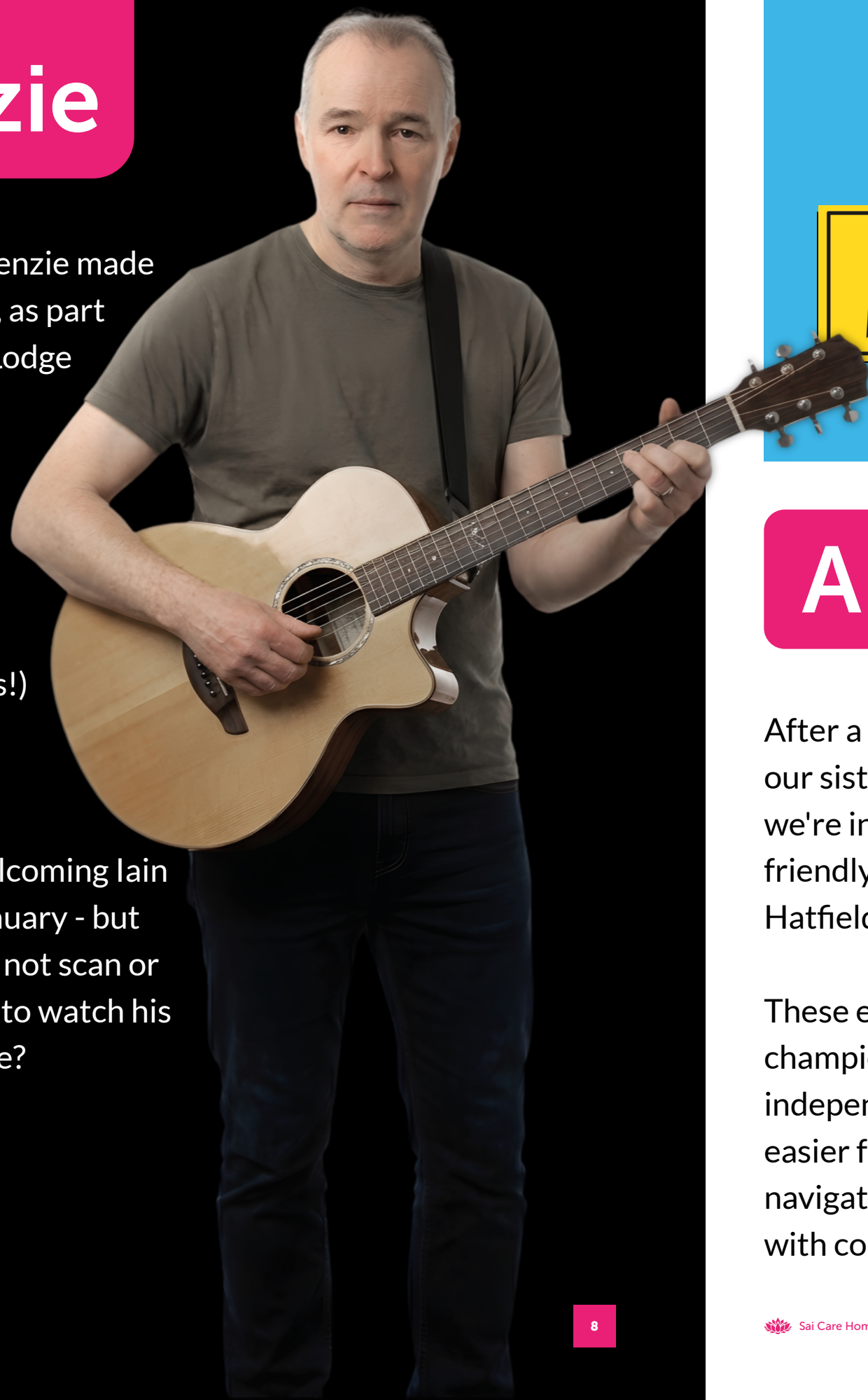
Iain McKenzie

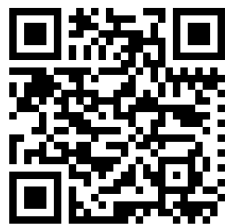
