THE WHITFIELD HALLOWEEN PARTY

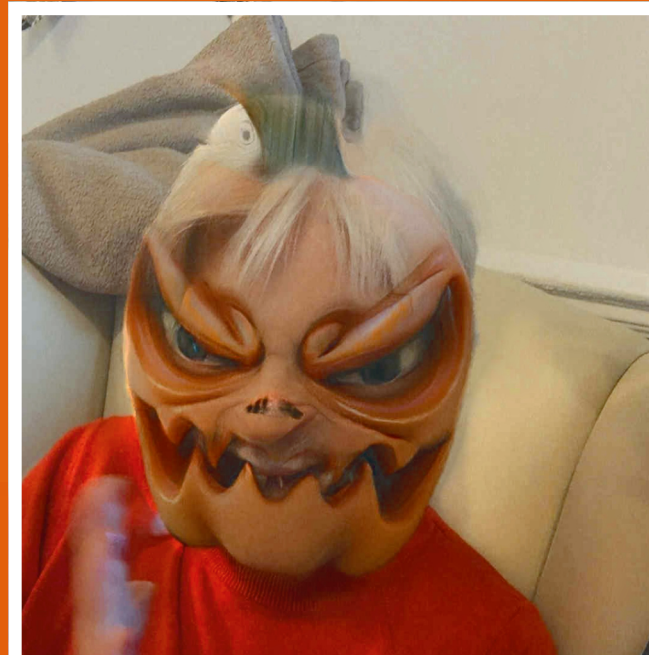
If you couldn't find any pumpkin ornaments in the shops last month, we might've been the cause, as Whitfield went above and beyond for Halloween this year.
